Requirements When Renting Your Fraternal Property or Facilities

UPDATED 5/23/08

When renting your Lodge, property, or facilities either for a fixed amount of money or gratis, the requirements listed below must be followed when alcohol is being served during such rental.

1. The person or party to whom you rent must carry Special Events Coverage with limits of at least \$1,000,000.00 for General Liability including \$1,000,000.00 for Liquor Liability. The Lodge or Service Center and Moose International, Inc. must be named as additional insureds under the coverage. Proof of insurance must be provided prior to the event. Failure to follow these requirements will result in there being no insurance coverage for any claims arising out of the event, gathering, party, reunion, reception, or other activity for which the Lodge, property or facilities have been rented.

These requirements apply regardless of whether or not the renter is a Moose member. All other requirements, including requirements placed by the General Governor's office, remain in full effect.

This update supersedes and replaces all guidelines issued prior to 5/23/08.
